## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Ronald H. Miller, Village Solicitor for the Village of Buckland, did file with the Board of Auglaize County Commissioners a petition and map for the annexation of lands (7.8 Acres, more or less) to the Village of Buckland; description as follows:

Situate in the Township of Logan, County of Auglaize and State of Ohio, to-wit:

Commencing at the intersection of the centerline of State Route 197 and the south line of Section Two (2), Town Four (4) South, Range Five (5) East, Logan Township, Auglaize County, Ohio; thence east along the south line of said Section 2 a distance of 578.78 feet to a point; thence north with an interior angle of 92 degrees and 35 minutes a distance of 592.17 feet to a point; thence west parallel with the south section line of said Section 2 a distance of 582.3 feet to a point in the center line of State Route 197; thence south along the center line of said State Route a distance of 592.17 feet to the place of beginning.

and,

WHEREAS, said territory, as specified in above description, is contiguous to the Village of Buckland and owned, in its entirety, by said Village of Buckland; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code, Section 709.16 - "If the only territory to be annexed is contiguous territory owned by the municipal corporation seeking annexation and if such territory is located entirely within the same county as the municipal corporation seeking annexation, upon receipt of the petition -- the Board of county commissioners shall, by resolution, approve the annexation--." -- "The annexation shall be complete upon the entry, pursuant to the Board's resolution, of an order upon the journal of the board authorizing such annexation."

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners does hereby accept the petition for annexation of above described lands to the Village of Buckland as filed by the Village Solicitor Miller; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, pursuant to the O.R.C., Section 709.16, said Board does hereby approve the annexation of lands to the Village of Buckland as petitioned by said Village.

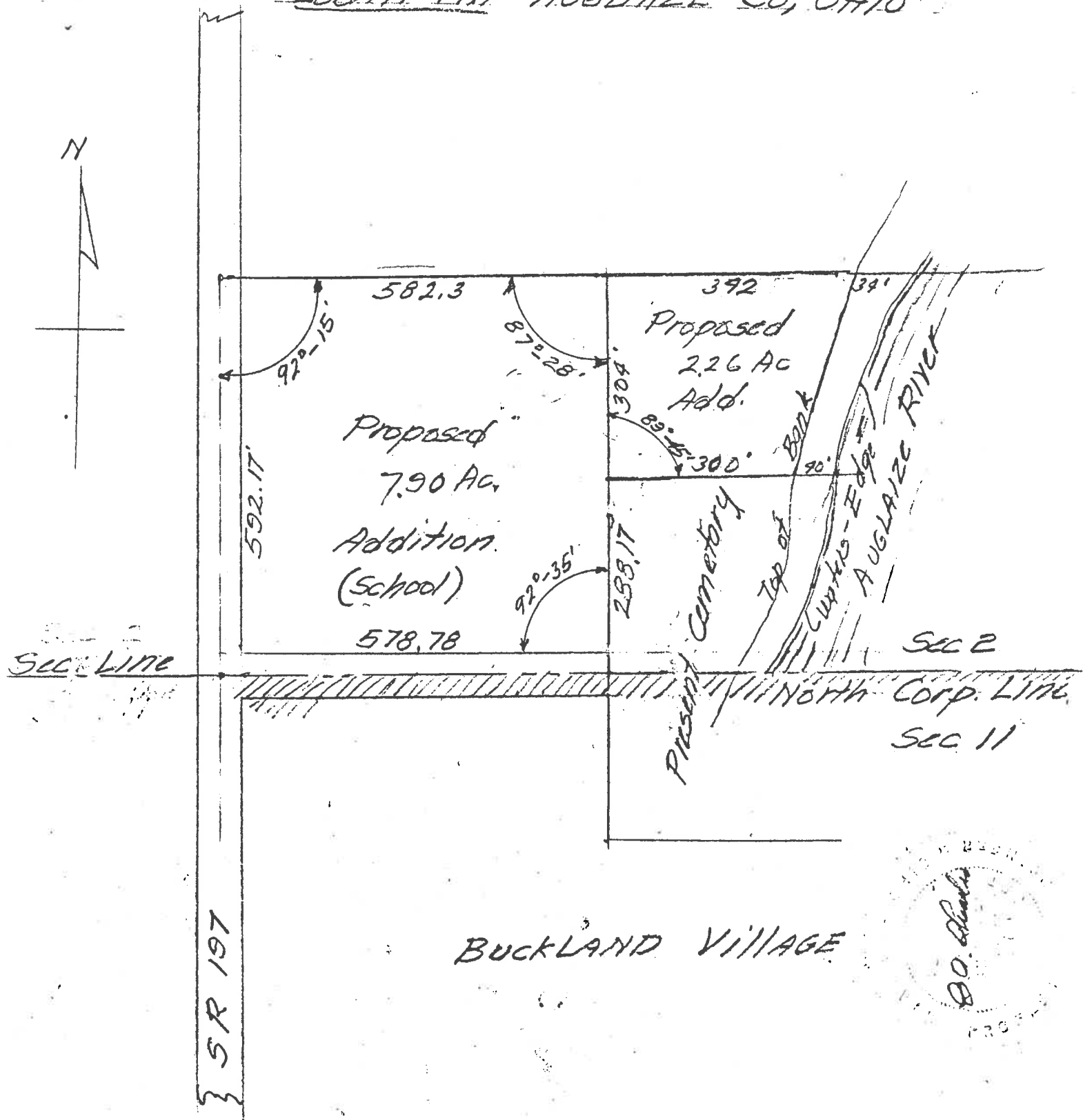
