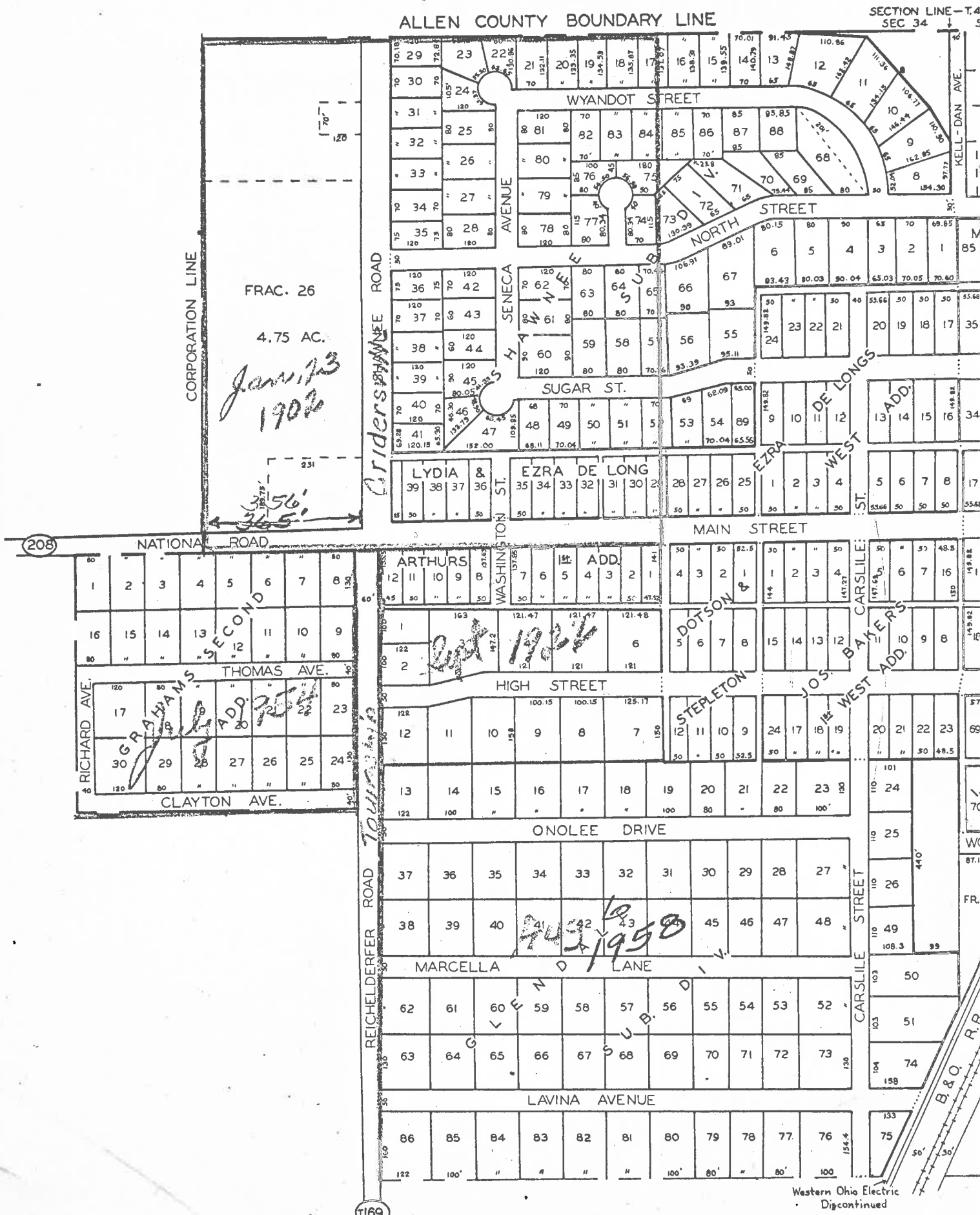

ORDINANCE NO. 1052.

TO AUTHORIZE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE VILLAGE OF
CRIDERSVILLE, OHIO

BE IT ORDAINED by the council of the Village of Cridersville, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the annexation of the following described territory:

Situate in the Township of Duchouquet, County of Auglaize and State of Ohio, to-wit:

Situate in the northeast quarter of Section 34, Town 4 South, Range 6 East, Duchouquet Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, described as follows;

Beginning on the south line of the National Road 640 feet east of the west line of said quarter section; thence south parallel to said west line 135 feet to a point; thence east parallel to the south line of the National Road 640 feet to the west line of the Reichelderfer Road; thence south along said west line 465 feet to a point; thence west parallel to the south line of the National Road 640 feet to a point; thence north parallel to the west line of Reichelderfer Road 465 feet to a point, the place of beginning.

Said above described real estate is also known as a part of Graham's Second Addition to the Village of Cridersville, and further known as Lots numbered 9 to 30 inclusive, except 5 feet off of the north end of Lots 9 to 16 inclusive, and also including Thomas Avenue, Clayton Avenue and Richard Avenue as shown by plat of Graham's Second Addition to the Village of Cridersville in Plat Book "B" page 14 of the plat records of Auglaize County, Ohio;

to the Village of Cridersville, Ohio, be and the same is hereby authorized.

Section 2. That the solicitor of said village be and he is hereby authorized to prosecute the proceedings necessary to effect such annexation.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
