The said alley has not been used for a period of not less than tairty (30) years. The alley being 16.5 feet wide by 250 feet long is described as follows: commencing at the NW corner of Lot 60 in George Geyer's First Addition, Village of Geyer, Clay Township, Auglaize County. State of Ohio, thence in a northeasterly direction along the north boundry lines of Lots 60, 59,58,57, and 56 a total distance of 250 feet to the west right-of-way of the D.T. & I. railroad, thence in a northwesterly direction along the railroad right-of-way a total distance of 16.5 feet, thence in a southwesterly direction along the south boundry lines of Lots 55,54,53,52, and 51 a total distance of 250 feet to the SW corner of Lot 51, thence in a southeasterly direction along the east right-of-way of Elm Street a total distance of 16.5 feet to the point of origin. I, David Minnich, being sole owner of the lots bordering on the aforementioned alley, petition the Auglaize County Commissioners to act upon this matter. ## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners having given the county engineer the petition for the vacation of an alley, in the village of Geyer- for his study as to correct description-etc.; and

WHEREAS, the following report was this day filed with the Board:

## Gentlemen:

I have received your request from Mr. David Minnich to close and vacate an alley between Elm street and D. T. & I. R.R. in Geyer- Auglaize County, Ohio.

In the 5th line of his description, I am sure that Mr. Minnich has used the word east when he should have used the word west; in referring to the west right-of-way line of the C.T. & I R. R.

I am sure that you people can not act in any manner upon the ground owned by the D. T. & I R. R. and as he has petitioned you, this is the case that you would be doing if you followed his petition verbatim.

While that word is being changed, it is important to me as county engineer, that the word easterly in the third line of his description be changed to northeasterly and that the word northerly in the 6th line of his description be changed to southwesterly; that the word westerly in the 8th line be changed to southwesterly; that the word southerly in the 11th line be changed to southeasterly.

Also while the description is being retyped, I ask that the word "the" be placed between the two words "to" and "point" on the 12th line of his description.

After these corrections, modifications and additions are made to the description I will then review the description and give you my approval for the closing and vacating of the alley.

I am submitting herewith a retyped copy as the description should read as well as his original copy.

**GENTLEMEN:** 

IT IS THE INTENT OF THIS LETTERTO SERVE AS A REQUEST FOR THE CLOSING AND PERMANENT VACATION OF AN ALLEY, AS LATER DESCRIBED, IN THE VILLAGE OF GEYER, CLAY TOWNSHIP, AUGLAIZE COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO. THE SAID ALLEY HAS NOT BEEN USED FOR A PERIOD OF NOT LESS THAN THIRTY (30) YEARS. THE ALLEY BEING 16.5 FEET WIDE BY 250 FEET LONG IS DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

COMMENCING AT THE NW CORNER OF LOT 60 IN GEORGE GEYER'S FIRST ADDITION, VILLAGE OF GEYER, CLAY TOWNSHIP, AUGLAIZE COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THENCE IN AN EASTERLY DIRECTION ALONG THE NORTH BOUNDRY LINES OF LOTS 60, 59, 58, 57, AND 56 A TOTAL DISTANCE OF 250 FEET TO THE EAST RIGHT-OF-WAY OF THE D.T.& I. RAILROAD, THENCE IN A NORTHERLY DIRECTION ALONG THE RAILROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY A TOTAL DISTANCE OF 16.5 FEET, THENCE IN A WESTERLY DIRECTION ALONG THE SOUTH BOUNDRY LINES OF LOTS 55, 54, 53, 52, AND 51 A TOTAL DISTANCE OF 250 FEET TO THE SW CORNER OF LOT 51, THENCE IN A SOUTHERLY DIRECTION ALONG THE EAST RIGHT-OF-WAY OF ELM STREET A TOTAL DISTANCE OF 16.5 FEET TO POINT OF ORIGIN.
