ORDINANCE NO. 1960-

ORDINANCE TO VACATE THE ALLEY LYING PARALLEL WITH AND BETWEEN OHIO AND CLEVELAND STREETS, FROM THE SOUTH LINE OF LOT 55 TO THE NORTH LINE OF LOT 58 BEING SO MUCH OF THE ALLEY AS LIES BETWEEN LOTS 55, 56, 57, and 58 K and 55, 56, 57, and 58 I.

Whereas, on the 3rd day of February 1960, a petition by the corporation owning lots in the immediate vicinity of the alley lying parallel with and between Ohio and Cleveland Streets, from the south line of lot 55 to the north line of lot 58 being so much of the alley as lies between lots 55, 56, 57, and 58 K and 55, 56, 57, and 58 L, was duly presented to council praying that said alley, between the points named, be vacated; and whereas said applicant is the owner of all property abutting said alley as described above and said applicant has consented to such vacation, and,

Whereas, council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made, now therefore,

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Minster, state of Ohio:

Section 1. That the alley lying parallel with and between Ohio and Cleveland Streets, from the south line of lot 55 to the north line of lot 58 being so much of the alley as lies between lots 55, 56, 57, and 58 K and 55, 56, 57, and 58 I be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. That this ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance because of the need to immediately vacate said alley.
