

ORDINANCE NO. 1960-10

ORDINANCE TO VACATE THE ALLEY LYING PARALLEL WITH AND BETWEEN OHIO AND CLEVELAND STREETS, FROM THE SOUTH LINE OF LOT 59 TO THE NORTH LINE OF LOT 60 BEING SO MUCH OF THE ALLEY AS LIES BETWEEN LOTS 59 AND 60 K AND 59 AND 60 I.

Whereas, on the 5th day of April 1960, a petition by all the owners owning lots in the immediate vicinity of the alley lying parallel with and between Ohio and Cleveland Streets, from the south line of Lot 59 to the north line of Lot 60 being so much of the alley as lies between Lots 59 and 60 K and 59 and 60 I, was duly presented to Council praying that said alley, between the points named, be vacated; and whereas said applicants are the owners of all property abutting said alley as described above and said applicant has consented to such vacation, and,

Whereas, council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made, now therefore,

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Minster, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the alley lying parallel with and between Ohio and Cleveland Streets, from the south line of Lot 59 to the north line of Lot 60, being so much of the alley as lies between Lots 59 and 60 K and 59 and 60 I be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. That this ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance because of the need to immediately vacate said alley.
