O R D I N A N C E N O. 1960- 17

TO VACATE THE ALLEY LYING PARALLEL WITH AND MIDWAY BETWEEN OHIO AND CLEVELAND STREETS, FROM FOURTH STREET TO FIFTH STREET, (BEING THE ALLEY LYING BETWEEN LOTS 37 THROUGH 48, BLOCK I, AND 37 THROUGH 48, BLOCK K)

Whereas, on the 7th day of June 1960, a petition by the corporations and persons owning all lots in the immediate vicinity of the alley lying parallel with and midway between Ohio and Cleveland Streets, from Fourth Street to Fifth Street, (being the alley lying between Lots 37 through 48, Block I, and 37 through 48, Block K) was duly presented to council praying that said alley, between the points named, be vacated; and whereas said applicants are the owners of all property abutting said alley as described above and said applicants have consented to such vacation; and,

Whereas, council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made, now therefore,

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Minster, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the alley lying parallel with and midway between Ohio and Cleveland Streets, from Fourth Street to Fifth Street, (being the alley lying between Lots 37 through 48, Block I, and 37 through 48, Block K) be and the same is hereby vacated with the Village retaining an easement for existing utilities.

Section 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance because of the need to immediately vacate said alley and shall, therefore, go into immediate effect.
