ORDINANCE TO VACATE A PART OF NORTH
OHIO STREET AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

Ordinance No. 2154

1st part: To vacate a strip of ground ten (10) feet wide and three hundred twenty five (325) feet long on North Ohio Street in the village of Minster, County of Auglaize and State of Ohio.

2nd part. To vacate a strip of ground ten (10) feet wide and two hundred twelve and 50/100 (212.50) feet long on north Ohio street in the Village of Minster, County of Auglaize and State of Ohio.

WHEREAS, on the 5th day of August, 1952, a Petition by the owner of lots number 45,46,47, and 48, Block "K" and the west end of Fifth Street in the village of Minster, Auglaize county, Ohio, was duly presented to council praying that a strip of ground on Ohio Street 10 feet wide and 325 feet

long abutting the above described property be vacated.

WHEREAS, on the 5th day of August, 1952, a Petition by the owner of lots No. 52,53, and 54,

ORDINANCE TO VACATE THE WEST END OF FIFTH STREET AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO.2148

To vacate 235.58 feet off of the extreme west end of Fifth Street, measuring East and West

between Ohio and Ceveland Streets in the Village of Minster, Auglaize county, Ohio.
