

## PETITION TO COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

To the Commissioners of Auglaize County, State of Ohio:

The Village of Minster respectfully represents that by an ordinance duly passed by its council on the 2nd day of November, 1971, the following described territory was authorized to be annexed to said village, to-wit:
