AN ORDINANCE TO ACCEPT THE APPLICATION FOR THE ANNEXATION
OF CERTAIN TERRITORY CONTAINING 1.05 ACRES IN JACKSON TOWNSHIP
TO THE VILLAGE OF MINSTER, OHIO

WHEREAS, a Petition for the annexation of certain territory in Jackson Township was duly filed by the Board of Education of the Minster Local School District; and

WHEREAS, the said petition was duly considered by the Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio, on June 13, 1972; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has approved the annexation of said territory to the Village of Minster and is hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners certify the transcript of proceedings in connection with said annexation with the map and petition required in connection therewith to the City Clerk who received the same on June 14, 1972; and,

WHEREAS, sixty-days from the date of said filing has now elapsed in accordance with the provision of Ohio Revised Code Section 709.04; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Minster, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the proposed annexation is applied for in the petition of the Board of Education of the Minster Local School District and a majority of owners of real estate in the territory sought to be annexed and filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio, on April 11, 1972, in which said petition prayed for annexation to the Village of Minster, Ohio, a certain territory adjacent thereto as hereinafter described, and which said petition was approved for annexation to the village of Minster, Ohio, by the Board of County Commissioners on June 13, 1972, being the same is hereby accepted. Said territory is described as follows:

Situate in the Township of Jackson, County of Auglaize, Ohio, to-wit:

Being a tract of land comprising one and five hundredths (1.05) acres measuring two hundred eighty-two and six tenths feet (282.6) from north to south and one hundred sixty-one and three tenths feet (161.3) from east to west, being the north part of the east part of Outlot Number One (1), the said east part containing two and forty-six hundredths acres (2.46) as it is shown on the recorded plat of said Outlot, said Outlot being laid off on the south side of the northeast quarter of Section twenty-seven (27), town seven (7) south, range four (4) east.

The certified transcript of the proceedings for annexation with an accurate map of said territory, together with the petition for its annexation, and other papers relating to the proceedings hereto of said County Commissioners are all on file with the Clerk of the Village and have been for more than sixty days.

SECTION 2. That the Village Clerk be and he is hereby authorized and directed to make three copies of this Ordinance to each of which shall be attached a copy of the map accompanying the petition for annexation, a copy of the transcript of proceedings of the Board of County Commissioners relating thereto, and a certificate as to the correctness thereof. The Village Clerk shall then forthwith deliver one copy to the County Auditor, one copy to the County Recorder, and one copy to the Secretary of State and shall file notice of this annexation with the Board of Elections within thirty days after it becomes effective, and said clerk shall do all other things required by law.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take affect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
