PETITION TO COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR ANNEXATION

To the Board of County Commissioners, Auglaize County, Ohio:

Gentlemen:

The Council of the Village of Minster, Aualgize County, Ohio, did on the 2nd day of September, 1975 duly adopt Ordinance No. 75-9-2, which ordinance authorized the annexation to the Village of the hereinafter described contiguous territory, to wit:


