AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE VILLAGE OF NEW BREMEN, OHIO, AND TO DEGLARE AN EMERGENCY

Section 1. That the annexation of the following described territory:


