for and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to bemade, now, therefore, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW BREMEN, AUGLAIZE COUNTY, OHIO. Section 1, That a certain unnamed street lying between Flum Street and Front Street and bound-

ed on the west by Canal Lands and on the East by Canal Street in the Village of New Bremen,

Auglaize County, Ohio, be, and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2, That this ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed
