

PETITION TO COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

To the Commissioners of Auglaize County, State of Ohio:

The Village of New Bremen respectfully represents that by an ordinance duly passed by its council on the 13th day of June, 1967, the following described territory was authorized to be annexed to said village to-wit:

The following tract of land is part of the Southwest Quarter of Section Ten (10), Town Seven (7) South, Range Four (4) East, with reference to the First Principal Meridian, German Township, Auglaize County, Ohio.

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY
TO THE VILLAGE OF NEW BREMEN, OHIO, AND TO DECLARE AN
EMERGENCY

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of New Bremen, Ohio, that:

Section 1. That the annexation of the following described territory:

The following tract of land is part of the Southwest Quarter of Section Ten (10), Town Seven (7) South, Range Four (4) East, with reference to the First Principal Meridian, German Township, Auglaize County, Ohio.

Section 3. Because of the need to complete this annexation as soon as possible this ordinance is declared to be an emergency ordinance and this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


