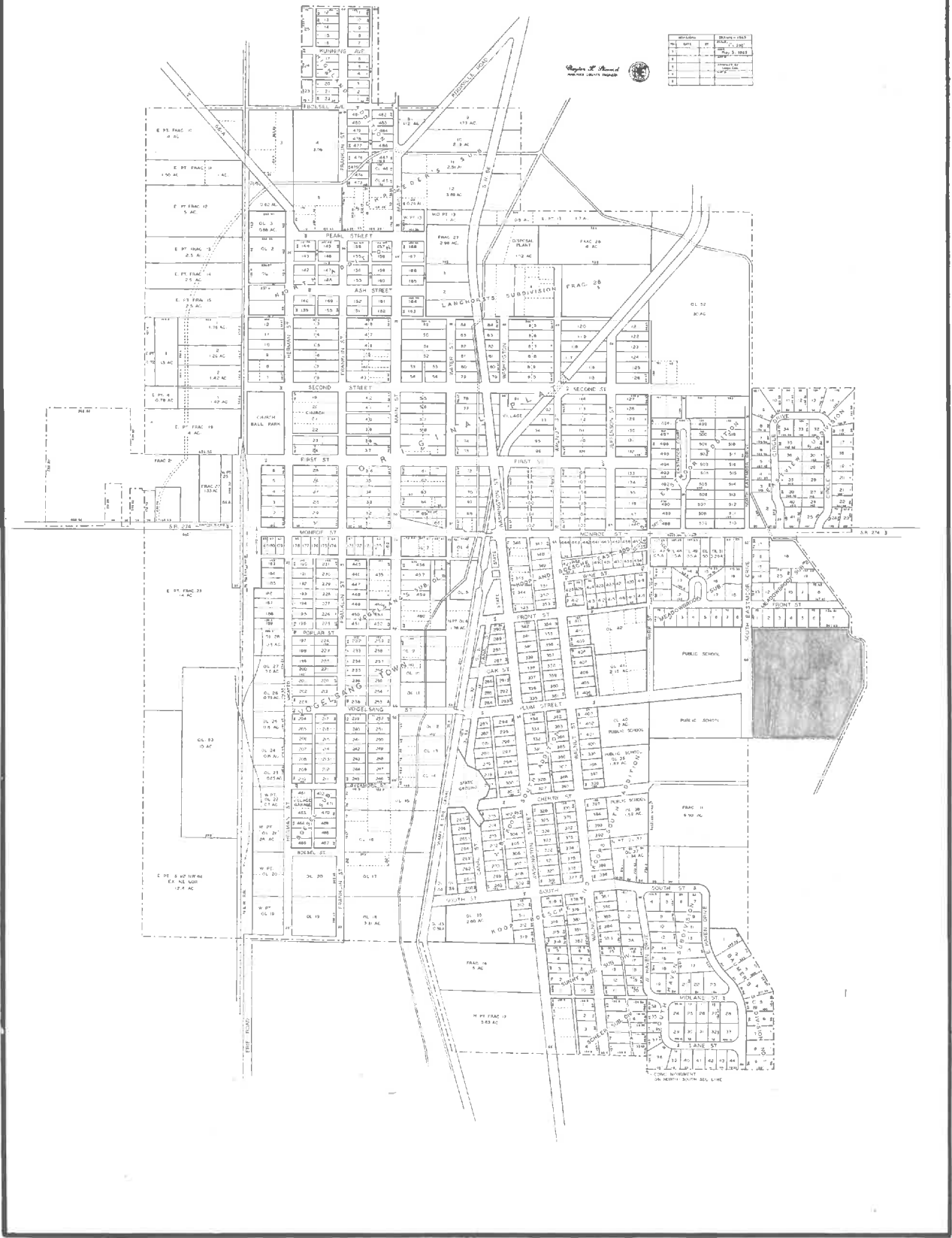

APETITION FOR ANNEXATION TO THE
VILLAGE OF NEW BREMEN, OHIO


TO: THE COMMISSIONERS OF AUGLAIZE COUNTY,
STATE OF OHIO:

The Village of New Bremen, Ohio, respectfully represents that an ordinance was duly passed by its Council on the 14th day of May, 1968, wherein the following described territory was authorized to be annexed to the Village of New Bremen:

Being a tract of ground situated in the North one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northwest Quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Fourteen (14), German Township, Town Seven (7) South, Range Four (4) East, with reference to the First Principal Meridian, Auglaize County, Ohio, and more particularly described as follows: Commencing at an iron pin at the Northwest corner of said Section Fourteen (14); thence South four degrees ($4^{\circ}0'$) East along the West line of said Section Fourteen (14), a distance of 607.98 feet to an iron pin; thence North $85^{\circ}02'$ East, a distance of 653.69 feet to an iron pipe on the East corporation line of the Village of New Bremen, which is the place of beginning; thence continuing North $85^{\circ}02'$ East, a distance of 669.26 feet to an iron pipe; thence South $4^{\circ}19'$ East, a distance of 50.45 feet to an iron pipe; thence South $86^{\circ}40'$ East, a distance of 106.78 feet to an iron pipe in the center of a stream; thence South $4^{\circ}32'$ East along the centerline of a stream 340.85 feet to an iron pipe; thence South $24^{\circ}56'$ West along the centerline of a stream 370.57 feet to an iron pipe; thence South $85^{\circ}02'$ West, a distance of 591.05 feet to an iron pipe on the East corporation line of New Bremen; thence in a Northerly direction along the East corporation line of the Village of New Bremen, a distance of 726 feet, more or less to an iron pipe, which is the place of beginning, in all containing 9.59 acres.

And the said Village respectfully petitions that the said territory be annexed to the said Village of New Bremen, Ohio.

ORDINANCE NO. 1968-5-9

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING ANNEXATION BY THE
VILLAGE OF NEW BREMEN, OHIO, OF CERTAIN TERRITORY.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL FOR THE VILLAGE OF
NEW BREMEN, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the annexation of the following described property;

Being a tract of ground situated in the North one-half (1/2)
of the Northwest Quarter (1/4) of Section Fourteen (14), German
Township, Town Seven (7) South, Range Four (4) East, with
reference to the First Principal Meridian, Auglaize County, Ohio,
and more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at an iron pin at the Northwest corner of said
Section Fourteen (14); thence South four degrees (4°0') East
along the West line of said Section Fourteen (14), a distance
of 607.98 feet to an iron pin; thence North 85°02' East, a
distance of 653.69 feet to an iron pipe on the East corporation
line of the Village of New Bremen, which is the place of
beginning; thence continuing North 85°02' East, a distance
of 669.26 feet to an iron pipe; thence South 4°19' East, a
distance of 50.45 feet to an iron pipe; thence South 85°40'
East, a distance of 106.78 feet to an iron pipe in the center
of a stream; thence South 4°32' East along the centerline of
a stream 340.85 feet to an iron pipe; thence South 24°56'
West along the centerline of a stream 370.57 feet to an iron
pipe; thence South 85°02' West, a distance of 591.95 feet
to an iron pipe on the East corporation line of New Bremen;
thence in a Northerly direction along the East corporation
line of the Village of New Bremen, a distance of 726 feet,
more or less to an iron pipe, which is the place of beginning,
in all containing 9.59 acres,

to the Village of New Bremen, be and is hereby authorized.

SECTION 2. That the Attorney for the Petitioners be and he is hereby
authorized and directed to prosecute the proceedings necessary to effect
such annexation.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect at the
earliest possible date provided by law.
