## ORDINANCE NO. 1976-8-14

## AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING APPLICATION FOR ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY TO THE VILLAGE OF NEW BREMEN, OHIO AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of New Bremen, Auglaize County, Ohio, to-wit:

SECTION 1. That the application of Nathan Hirschfeld, Frederick L. Luedeke, Dorothy L. Luedeke and Hermiva W. Obringer for annexation of the following described territory to the Village of New Bremen is hereby accepted.

An accurate map of which territory, together with the petition for annexation and other papers relating thereto, and a certified transcript of the proceedings of the County Commissioners in relation thereto on file with the Clerk of Council said Village, and have been as required by law,

SECTION 2. The territory being accepted for annexation is described as follows:

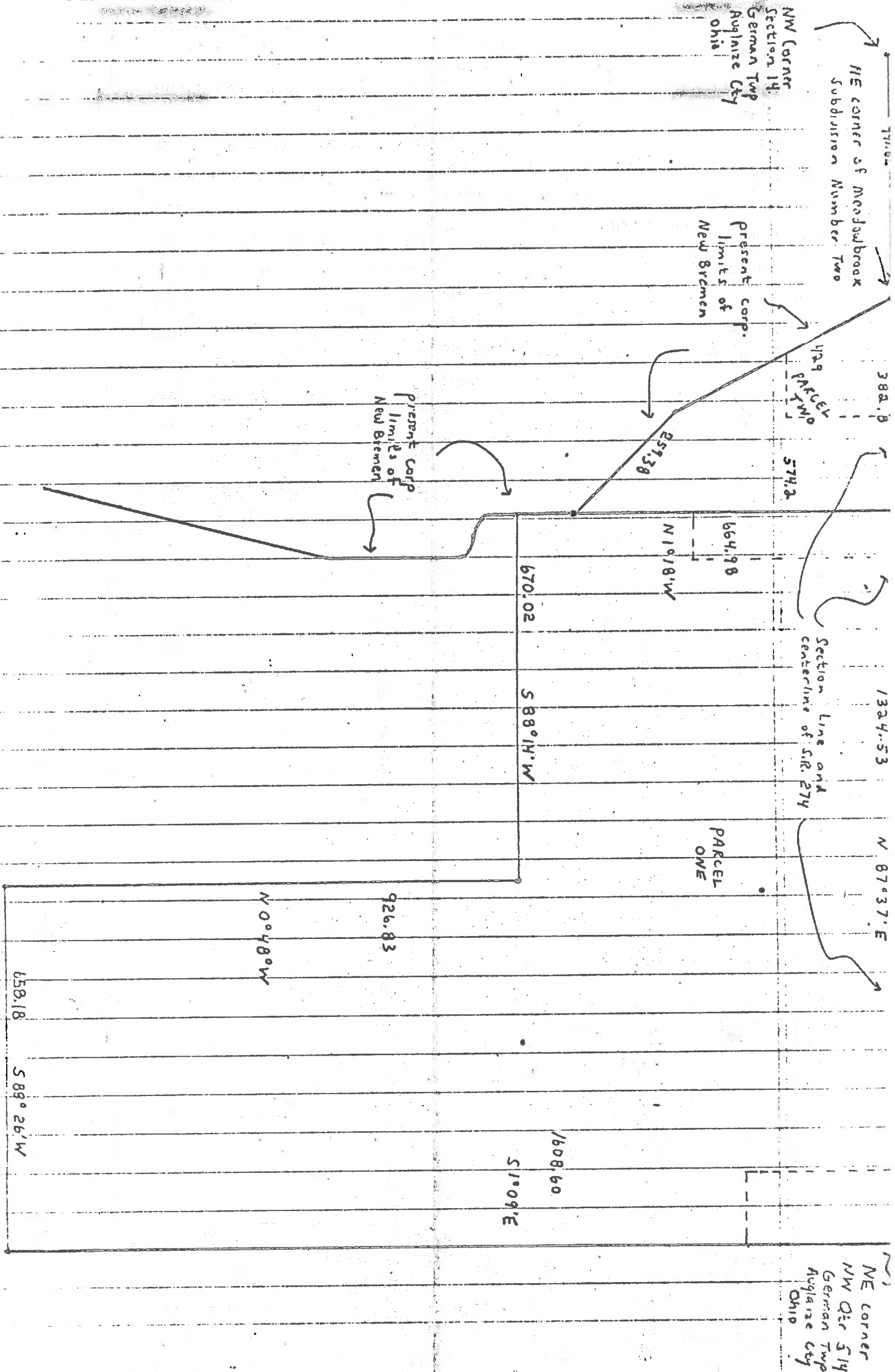
