The undersigned, being a majority of the owners of the real estate of the following described territory situated in the County of Auglaize and adjacent to the Village of New Knoxville, Ohio, to-wit:

Section Thirty(30), Township Six (6) South, Range Five (5) East of the Township of Washington, Auglaize County, State of Ohio, to-wit: Commencing at the Northeast corner of the Southeast Quarter of said section; said northeast corner being the intersection of the south corporation line and the centerline of State Route No. 29; thence South on the East Section line and the centerline of State Route 29, a distance of Four Hundred Twelve and Five-tenths (412.5) feet to a point; thence West a distance of Five Hundred Forty-seven and Five-tenths (547.5) feet to a point; thence in a Northwesterly direction at an angle of Forty(40) degrees with the East Section line a distance of Sixty-two and Sixty-six one-hundredths (62.66) feet to a point; thence West a distance of One-hundred Eighty-eight and Seventy-two One-hundredths (188.72) feet to a point; thence North and parallel to the East Section line a distance of Three Hundred Sixty-four and Five-tenths (364.5) feet to a point on the half section line; thence East along the half section line a distance of Seven Hundred Seventy-six and Five-tenths (776.5) feet to a point which is the place of beginning.

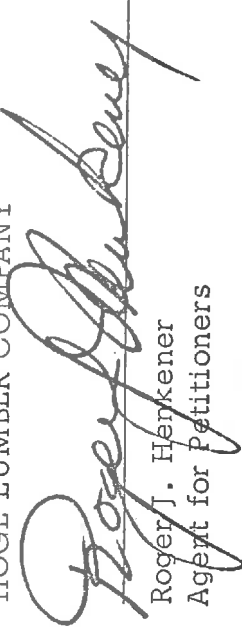
Respectfully petition that said above described territory may be annexed to the Village of New Knoxville, Ohio.

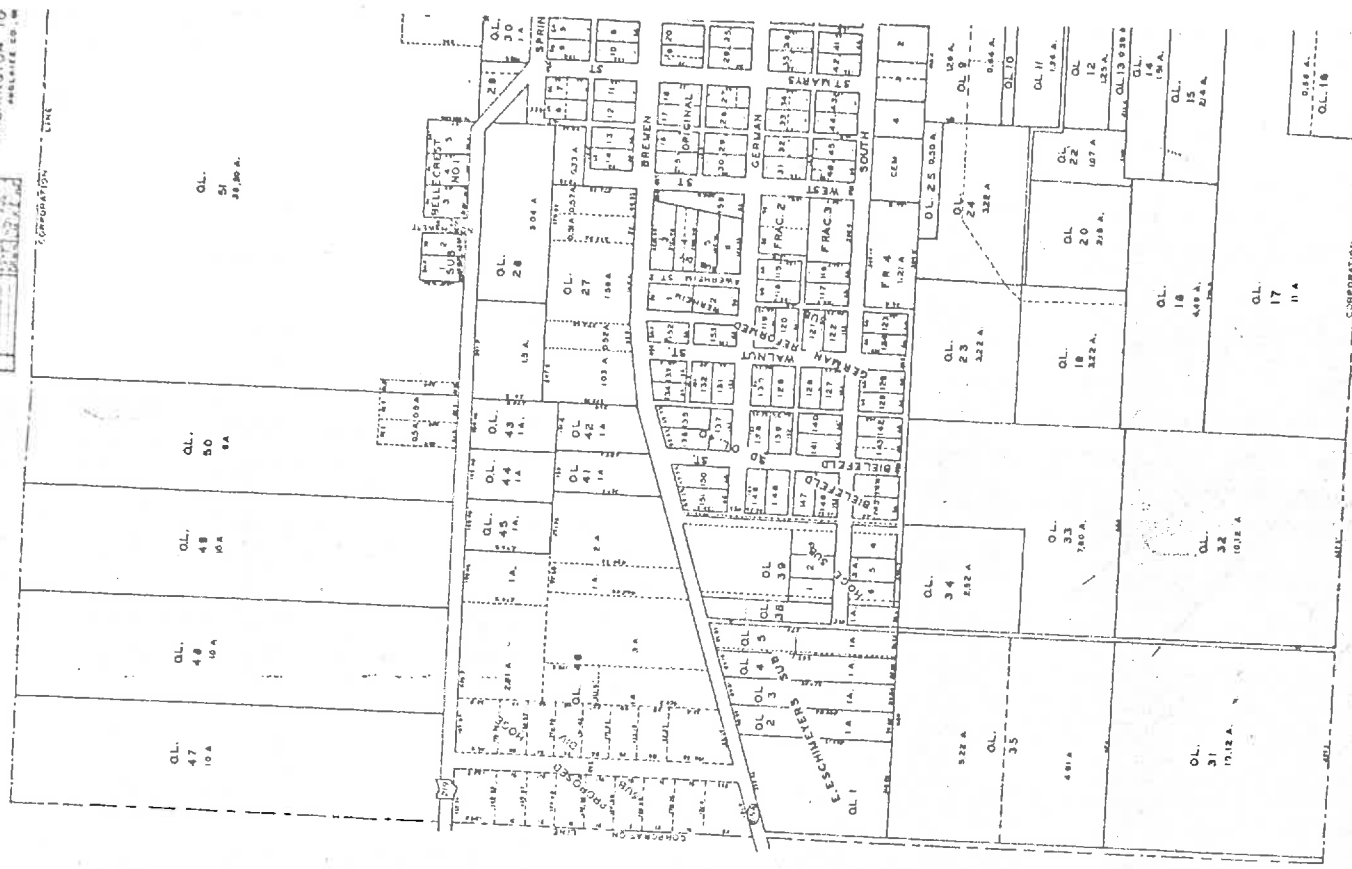

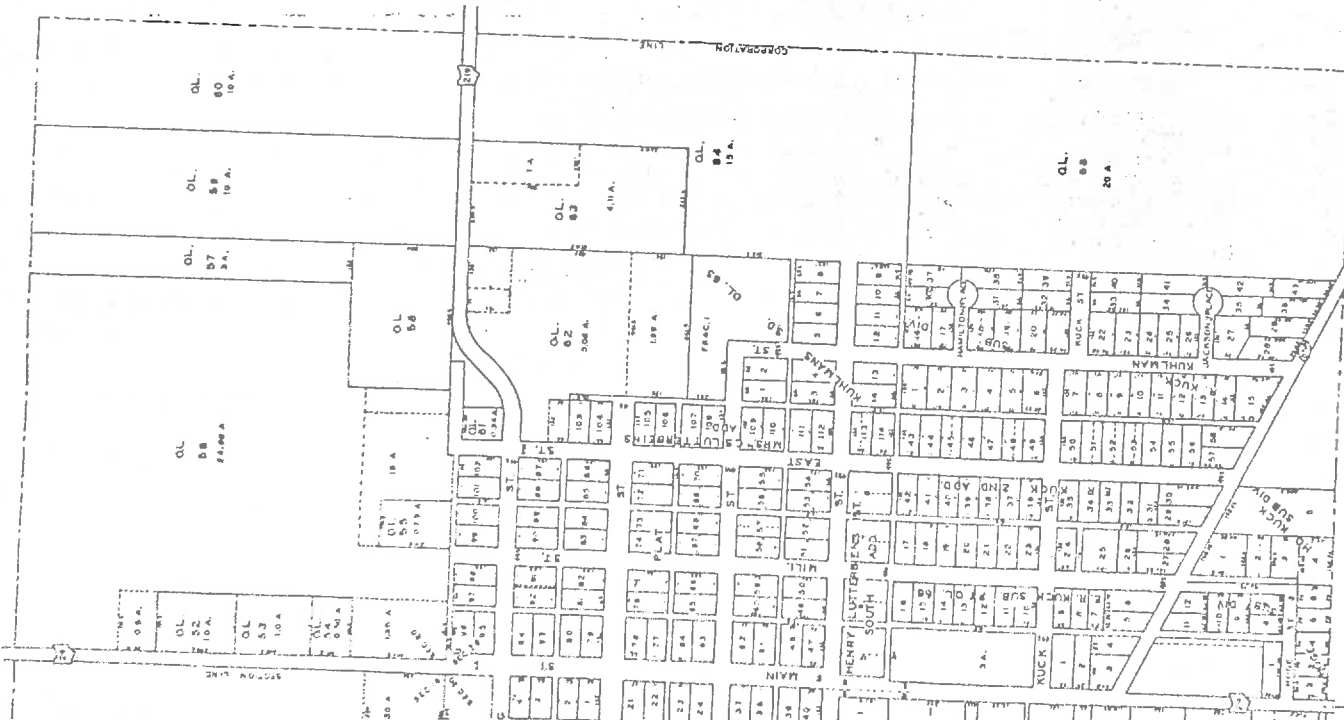
