REPORT OF COUNTY ENGINEER

IN THE MATTER OF
ST. JOHNS ALLEY
(Vacation of portion)

County Engineer's Office
Auglaize County, Ohio

To the Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio:

The undersigned, in obedience to your order of June 23rd, 1964 proceeded to make an accurate survey and plat of the Public Alley proposed to be vacated and respectfully submit the following report:

In the opinion of the undersigned the East portion of the Public Alley should be vacated.

An accuredated survey and plat, of that portion of the Alley to be vacated, accompany this report and are made a part hereof.

An accurate and detailed description of the proposed alteration is as follows:

Commencing at the South West Corner of Lot #62 Looneys Addition in the Village of St Johns, Auglaize County, Ohio; thence East on the South line of Lots #62-#63 and #64 a distance of 198 feet to the South East Corner of Lot #64. Thence south 16.5 feet to the North East Corner of Out Lot #21. Thence west on the North line of Out Lot #21 a distance of 198 feet to the North West corner of Out Lot #21. Thence north 16.5 feet to the place of beginning.

Said Alley having a recorded width of 16.5 feet.

This portion of said alley is not built or maintained to carry traffic and dead ends on the west end. The alleys is not needed by the abutting property owners for ingress or egress and should be vacated.
