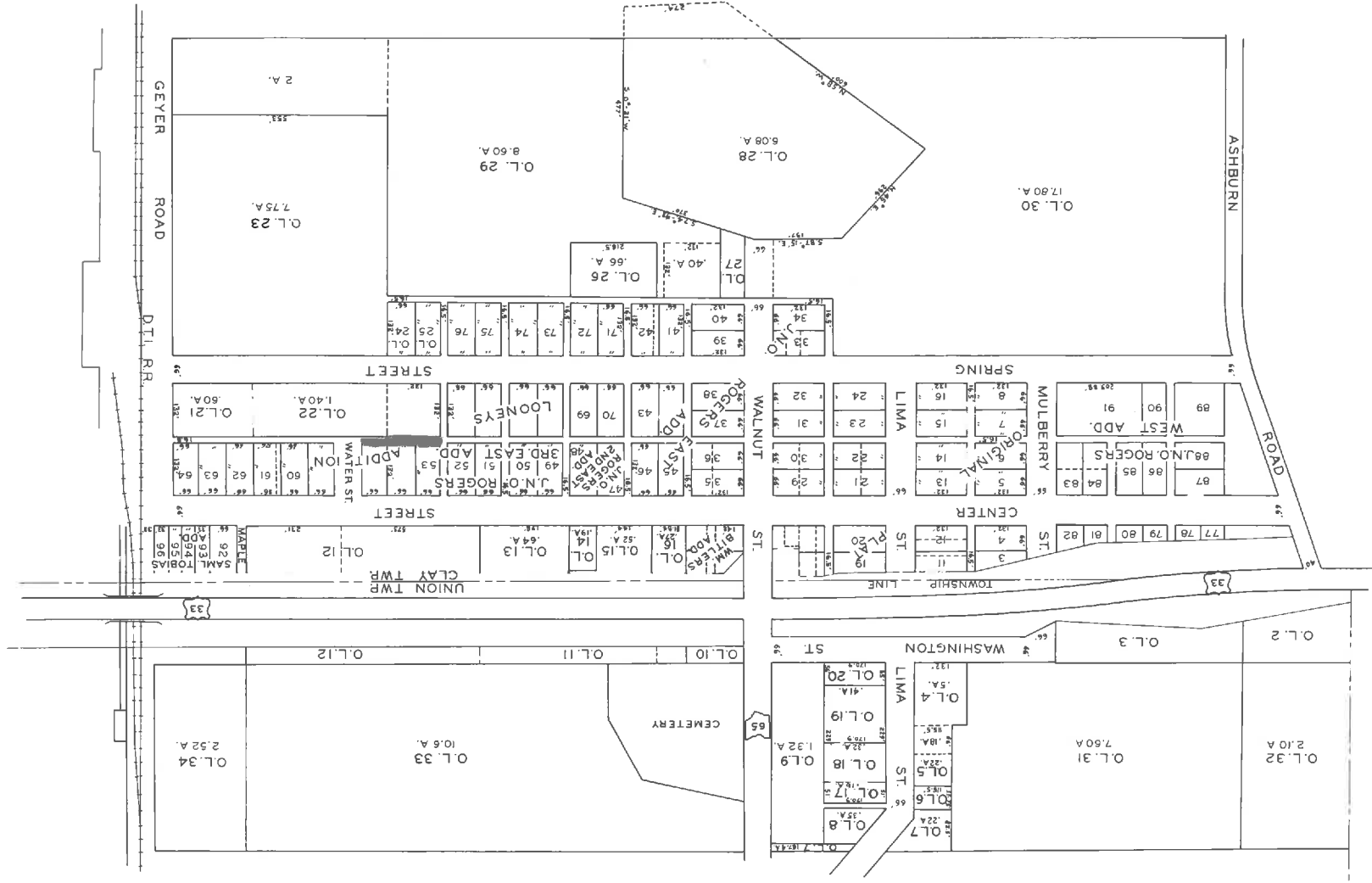

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RESOLUTION

TO VACATE THAT PORTION OF THE PUBLIC ALLEY LOCATED IMMEDIATELY SOUTH OF LOTS 53, 57, 58 OF LOONEY'S ADDITION IN THE VILLAGE OF ST. JOHNS, AUGLAIZE COUNTY, OHIO

WHEREAS, a written petition has been presented to the Board of County Commissioners to vacate that portion of the east-west alley in the Village of St. Johns lying immediately south of Lots #53, 57, 58 in Looney's Addition, the easterly portion of said alley intersecting a north-south end of Water Street and the westerly portion intersecting a north-south alley east of Lots #52 and 65 and connecting Center Street and Spring Street; and

AND WHEREAS, in order to determine whether it will be for the public convenience or welfare to vacate said portion of the alley described, it is necessary that the Board of County Commissioners view the proposed vacation and set a date for a final hearing thereon, pursuant to the requirements set forth in R.C. 5553.05;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners will view the proposed alley to be vacated on May 15th, 1984, at 2:00 P.M. o'clock, and will hold a final hearing thereon in the Office of the County Commissioners in the Auglaize County Courthouse, Wapakoneta, Ohio, on May 22nd, 1984, at 2:00 p.m., to adopt a resolution to vacate said public alley.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the proper notice be published in the WAPAKONETA DAILY NEWS once a week for two consecutive weeks prior to the date of the viewing heretofore described, and that a copy of this Resolution be mailed to those persons set forth herein and to the Ohio Director of Natural Resources at least twenty (20) days before the date of the public hearing fixed in this Resolution.

Upon a Motion by Mr. Wagner, seconded by Mr. Vogel, a vote on the adoption of this Resolution was as follows:

R E S O L U T I O N

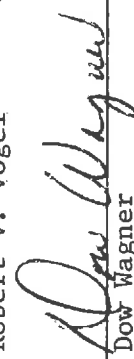
(As also ordered on April 24, 1984, the Board of County Commissioners did view site of proposed alley vacation, with no one else present.)
