

✓ PETITION OF THE CITY OF ST. MARYS, OHIO FOR ANNEXATION
OF TERRITORY.

TO THE HONORABLE COMMISSIONERS OF AUGLAIZE COUNTY, OHIO:

The City of St. Marys, Ohio respectfully represents that by Ordinance duly passed by its Council on the 12th. day of March, 1945 the following described territory; viz:

Commencing at the corner stone in the center of Section 10, Town Six (6) South, Range Four (4) East, St. Marys Township, Auglaize County, Ohio; thence East on the half ($\frac{1}{2}$) Section line a distance of five hundred sixteen (516.0) feet to a point, this being the place of the beginning.

Thence South with an interior angle of $89^{\circ}26'$ a distance of Fourteen hundred and seventy-three (1473.0) feet to a stake; thence Northwesterly with an interior angle of $71^{\circ}6'$ a distance of thirty three and five tenths (33.5) feet to a stake; thence Southwesterly with an interior angle of $214^{\circ}21'$ a distance of two hundred eleven and five tenths (211.5) feet to a stake; thence Southwesterly with an interior angle of $182^{\circ}52'$ a distance of two hundred and five tenths (201.5) feet to a stake; thence continuing southwesterly with an interior angle of $168^{\circ}56'$ a distance of two hundred six (206.0) feet to a stake.

Thence continuing Southwesterly with an interior angle of $198^{\circ}15'$ a distance of two hundred one (201.0) feet to a stake; thence continuing South westerly with an interior angle of $170^{\circ}7'$ a distance of two hundred one (201.0) feet to a stake; thence continuing Southwesterly with an interior angle of $198^{\circ}07'$ a distance of two hundred five and five tenths (205.5) feet to a stake; thence continuing South Westerly with an interior angle of $166^{\circ}12'$ a distance of one hundred thirty four and four tenths (134.4) feet to an iron pin.

Thence continuing South Westerly with an interior angle of $179^{\circ}2'$ a distance of sixty two and three hundredths (62.03) feet to an iron pin; thence continuing South Westerly with an interior angle of $180^{\circ}35'$ a distance of two hundred and two hundredths (200.02) feet to an iron pin; thence continuing South Westerly with an interior angle of $173^{\circ}43'$ a distance of two hundred one and thirty four hundredths (201.34) feet to an iron pin; thence continuing South Westerly with an interior angle of $190^{\circ}52'$ a distance of seventy six and forty one hundredths (76.41) feet to an iron pin.

Thence North along the East right of way line of the New York Central and St. Louis Rail Road a distance of two thousand eleven and thirty one hundredths (2011.31) feet to an iron pin; thence East with an interior angle of $90^{\circ}5'$ a distance of four hundred seventy three (473.0) feet to an iron pin; thence North with an interior angle of $270^{\circ}15'$ a distance of one hundred thirty four and thirty nine hundredths (134.39) feet to a point; thence East sixty (60) feet to a point; thence East sixty (60) feet to a point; thence South (60) feet to a point; thence South three hundred thirty and five hundredths (330.5) feet to a point; thence East with an interior angle $89^{\circ}54'$ a distance of Seven hundred fifty and seventy five hundredths (750.75) feet to an iron pipe. thence North with an interior angle of $269^{\circ}05'$ a distance of three hundred twenty seven (327.0) feet to the corner stone of the place of the beginning.

CITY - - ORDINANCE NO. 1213 (St. Marys City)

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF ST. MARYS, OHIO: and DECLARING AN EMERGENCY THEREFORE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. MARYS, OHIO:

SECTION NO. 1:

That the annexation of the following described territory to wit:

Commencing at a corner stone in the center of Section 10, Town 6 South, Range 4 East, St. Marys Township, Auglaize County, Ohio; thence east on the half section line a distance of five hundred sixteen (516.0) feet to a point; this point being the place of the beginning.

Thence South with an interior angle of 89 26' a distance of fourteen hundred seventy three (1473.0) feet to a stake; thence Northwesterly with an interior angle of 71 6' a distance of thirty three and five tenths (33.5) feet to a stake; thence South Westerly with an interior angle of 214 21' a distance of two hundred eleven and five tenths (211.5) feet to a stake; thence Southwesterly with an interior angle of 122 52' a distance of Two Hundred one and five tenths (201.5) feet to a stake; thence continuing South Westerly with an interior angle 178 56 a distance of Two Hundred Six (206.0) feet to a stake.

Thence continuing Southwesterly with an interior angle of 198 15' a distance of two hundred one (201.0) feet to a stake; thence continuing southwesterly with an interior angle of 170 7' a distance of two hundred one (201.0) feet to a stake; thence continuing south westerly with an interior angle of 198 07' a distance of two hundred five and five tenths (205.05) feet to a stake; thence continuing south westerly with an interior angle of 166 12' a distance of one hundred thirty four and four tenths (134.4) feet to an iron pin.

Thence continuing South Westerly with an interior angle of 179 2' a distance of sixty two and three hundredths (62.03) feet to an iron pin; thence continuing Southwesterly with an interior angle of 180 35' a distance of two hundred and two hundredths (200.02) feet to an iron pin; thence continuing South Westerly with an interior angle of 173 43' a distance of two hundred and thirty four hundredths (201.34) feet to an iron pin; thence continuing South Westerly with an interior angle of 190 53' a distance of Seventy six and forty one hundredths (76.40) feet to an iron pin.

Thence North with an interior angle of 65 22' along the East Right of Way line of the New York Central and St. Louis Railroad a distance of twenty one hundred and thirty five and seven tenths (2135.07) feet to an iron pin.

Thence continuing North on the same line a distance of one hundred twenty four and thirty nine hundredths (124.39) feet to the intersection of the line with the South Corporation line of the City of St. Marys, Ohio.

Thence East with an interior angle of 90 05' a distance of twelve hundred eighty three and seventy five hundredths (1283.75) feet to the corner stone at the place of the beginning.

TO THE City of St. Marys, Ohio, be and the same is hereby authorized.

SECTION NO. 2:

That Tom Danaher as the City Solicitor be and he is hereby authorized to prosecute the proceedings necessary to affect such annexation.

SECTION NO. 3:

That this Ordinance shall be declared an emergency ordinance and measure necessary for the public peace, health and safety of the citizenry, and shall take effect and be in force immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.

✓ AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO 1213 RELATIVE TO THE DESCRIPTION OF TERRITORY TO BE INCORPORATED IN THE CITY OF ST.MARYS,OHIO, and declaring an Emergency Therefore.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST.MARYS,Ohio

SECTION NO.1:

That the last three (3) paragraphs of the description as evidenced and beginning "Thence North with an interior angle of 65 22' along the Right of Way line of the New York Central and St.Louis Railroad, etc.-- to and including twelve hundred eighty three and seventy five hundredths (1283.75) feet to the corner stone at the place of beginning." be intirely stricken out and held for naught.

SECTION NO.2:

That the following description be annexed, substituted therefore and made a part of the otherwise described territory in Ordinance No. 1213 and follow as such substituted paragraph therefore,viz:

Thence North along the East right of way line of the New York Central and St.Louis Railroad a distance of two thousand eleven and thirty one hundredths (2011.31) feet to an iron pin; thence East with an interior angle of 90 5' a distance of four hundred seventy three (473.0) feet to an iron pin; thence North with an interior angle of 270 15' a distance of one hundred twenty four and thirty nine hundredths (124.39) feet to a point; thence East sixty feet to a point; thence South three hundred thirty and five hundredths (330.05) feet to a point; thence East with an interior angle of 89 54' a distance of seven hundred fifty and seventy five hundredths (750.75) feet to an iron pipe; thence North with an interior angle of 269 05' a distance of three hundred twenty seven (327.0) feet to a corner stone at the place of beginning.

SECTION NO.3

That this Ordinance shall be declared an emergency Ordinance and measure,necessary for the public health, peace and safety of said City, in order that the immediate completion of enlargement and extension of the Electric Light and Power Plant of said City may be affected, and shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
