

ORDINANCE NO. 73-57

AN ORDINANCE DEDICATING PROPERTY TO THE PUBLIC
USE FOR RIGHT-OF-WAY PURPOSES

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF
ST. MARYS, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby dedicated to the public use for right-
of-way purposes, the following described real estate, to-wit:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of Outlot 45; thence
Westerly following the South line of Spring Street, 31 feet
to a point; thence Southerly parallel with the East line of
Outlot 45, 195 feet to a point; thence Easterly parallel with
the North line of South Street for a distance of 87 feet to
the true point of beginning; thence Southerly at right angles
with the previous line, a distance of 131.8 feet to a point
in the North line of South Street; thence Easterly along the
North line of South Street for a distance of 15 feet to a
point; thence Northerly at a right angle with the North line
of South Street for a distance of 215.8 feet to a point;
thence Westerly parallel with the North line of South Street,
15 feet to a point; thence Southerly 84 feet to the true place
of beginning.

SECTION 2. It is further directed that the necessary City maps be
changed to note the dedication as a right-of-way, and that a copy of the
ordinance be recorded in the Recorder's office, County of Auglaize, State of Ohio
for purposes of showing said dedication.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect at the
earliest possible date provided by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 1974

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE SOUTH
WAYNE STREET, ST. MARYS, OHIO,
AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on the 4th day of March 1964, the Council for the City of St. Marys, Ohio, was advised of the advisability to vacate a portion of South Wayne Street, in the City of St. Marys, Ohio, said street being that bisecting the Goodyear Tire and Rubber Company property, and

WHEREAS, Council is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. MARYS, OHIO:

Section 1. That the following portion of South Wayne Street, described as follows;

Being all that part of South Wayne Street, (St. Marys-New Bremen Highway) in the City of St. Marys, County of Auglaize and State of Ohio, as follows:

Beginning at a stone in the center of Section Ten (10), Town Six (6) South, Range Four (4) East; thence running West along the half section line of said Section a distance of 780.12 feet to an iron pin, said pin lying in the center of South Wayne Street (St. Marys-New Bremen Highway); thence South along the center line of said South Wayne Street, a distance of 370.5 feet, to a point, said point being the point of beginning; thence East on a line parallel with the half section line a distance of 30 feet to the East line of said South Wayne Street (St. Marys-New Bremen Highway); thence South along the East line of said South Wayne Street to a point, 30 feet East of an iron pin in the center line of South Wayne Street, said iron pin being 325 feet North of the intersection of the center line of South Wayne Street (St. Marys-New Bremen Highway) and the North right-of-way line of the Miami and Erie Canal Feeder; thence West with an interior angle of 90° on a line through said pin a distance of 60 feet, to the West boundary line of South Wayne Street (St. Marys-New Bremen Highway); thence at a right angle Northerly along the West boundary line of South Wayne Street and being 370.5 feet South of the half section line of Section Ten (10), in St. Marys Township; thence East on a line parallel with the half section line a distance of 30 feet to a point in the center of South Wayne Street (St. Marys-New Bremen Highway) being the place of beginning.

Said area described being all of that portion of South Wayne Street (St. Marys-New Bremen Highway) that lies between a point bounded on the North at a point 370.5 feet South of the half section line of Section Ten (10) and bounded on the South at a point 325 feet North of the intersection of the center line of South Wayne Street (St. Marys-New Bremen Highway) and the North right-of-way line of the Miami and Erie Canal Feeder,

be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. The City of St. Marys, Ohio, does hereby officially and by the enactment of this said ordinance consent to the vacation of the afore-described street.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance and the reason for the emergency lies in the fact that the immediate vacating of said street will be for the general health and welfare of the citizens of the City of St. Marys, County of Auglaize and State of Ohio.

Section 4. That this ordinance be in force immediately upon its passage.
