

ORDINANCE NO. 75-36

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VACATION OF CANAL STREET IN THE CITY OF ST. MARYS, OHIO

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF ST. MARYS, OHIO:

SECTION 1. The Council of the City of St. Marys does hereby declare that Canal Street right-of-way as shown on the plat, an extension of the East Addition in the City of St. Marys, County of Auglaize and State of Ohio, as recorded on the City Engineer's Records, Plat Book 1, Page 27, being more particularly described as follows: Being all that part of the Canal Street right-of-way lying between the north right-of-way line of South Street and a line which is parallel with and One Hundred Twelve and 20/100 (112.20) feet north of the north right-of-way line of South Street in the City of St. Marys, Auglaize County, Ohio; be and is hereby vacated.

SECTION 2. That the necessary notices be given to the people in accordance with the Ohio Revised Code of the intent to vacate said right-of-way; after the vacation that the maps of the City of St. Marys be adjusted accordingly to show said vacation.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall be in force and take effect at the earliest possible date provided by law.


