ORDINANCE NO. 1214

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1213 RELATIVE TO THE DESCRIPTION OF TERRITORY TO BE INCORPORATED IN TO THE CITY OF ST. MARYS, OHIO , AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY THEREFORE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. MARYS, OHIO

SECTION NO. 1 :

That the last three (3) paragraphs of the description as evidenced and beginning " Thence North with an interior angle of $65^{\circ}22'$ along the Right of Way line of the New York Central & St. Louis Railroad , etc. --- to and including twelve hundred eighty three and seventy five hundredths (1283.75) feet to the corner stone at the place of beginning ."

be entirely stricken out and held for naught .

SECTION NO. 2 :

That the following description be annexed, substituted therefore and made a part of the otherwise described territory in Ordinance No. 1213 and follow as such substituted paragraph therefore, viz :

Thence North along the East right of way line of the New York Central and St. Louis Railroad a distance of two thousand eleven and thirty one hundredths (2011.31) feet to an iron pin ; thence East with an interior angle of $90^{\circ}5'$ a distance of four hundred seventy three (473.0) feet to an iron pin; thence North with an interior angle of $270^{\circ}15'$ a distance of one hundred twenty four and thirty nine hundredths (124.39) feet to a point; thence East sixty feet to a point ; thence South three hundred thirty and five hundredths (330.05) feet to a point ; thence East with an interior angle of $89^{\circ}54'$ a distance of seven hundred fifty and seventy five hundredths (750.75) feet to an iron pipe; thence North with an interior angle of $269^{\circ}05'$ a distance of three hundred twenty seven (327.0) feet to a corner stone at the place of beginning.

SECTION NO. 3 :

That this Ordinance shall be declared an emergency Ordinance and measure, necessary for the public health, peace and safety of said City , in order that the immediate completion of enlargement and extension of the Electric Light and Power Plant of said City may be affected , and shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor .
