## ORDINANCE NO. 14/5

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE QUINBY ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ST. MARYS, OHIO.

WHEREAS, the property owner of the land embraced and described in the plat known as the Quinby Addition to the City of St. Marys, Ohio, and formerly being a part of the southeast quarter of Section Four (4), Town Six (6) South, Range Four (4) East, in St. Marys Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, has submitted said plat for annexation to the City of St. Marys, Ohio, and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 1387, passed on the 26th day of June, 1950, the Solicitor for the City of St. Marys, Ohio, was authorized to initiate proceedings to effect the annexation of said Quinby Addition, and

WHEREAS, said proceedings were followed in accordance with law, and the same was approved by the Commissioners for Auglaize County, Ohio, and

WHEREAS, the owner of said Quinby Addition has dedicated the streets appearing thereon to the public use and benefit forever,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF ST. MARYS, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the land embraced by the plat submitted herewith by the property owner of the real estate set forth thereon, along with the streets as they appear on said plat, is hereby approved and accepted by the Council for the City of St. Marys, Ohio, and will be known from this date forward as the Quinby Addition to the City of St. Marys, Ohio.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after the earliest period provided by law.
