ORDINANCE NO. 1605

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE ANNEXATION
OF CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF ST.
MARYS, OHIO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF ST. MARYS, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the annexation of the following described territory:
is hereby authorized:

Situated in the Township of St. Marys, County of Auglaize, and
State of Ohio, to-wit:

Being a strip of land twenty-five (25) feet in width, east and
west, and thirteen hundred sixty-six and five-tenths (1366.5) long,
north and south, lying immediately west of and adjacent to the pre-
mises described in Ordinance Numbered 1601, passed by the Council
for the City of St. Marys, Ohio, on December 12, 1955, and being
the west one-half (1/2) of Holly Street, as shown on a plat
and survey of said area and referred to as Hillsdale Fourth Addition
to the City of St. Marys, Ohio; prepared by B. R. Gebhart, to which
plat reference is hereby made.

SECTION 2. That there are no electors residing in the above described
territory, the annexation of which is hereby authorized and therefore the
provisions of Section 709.17 of the Revised Code of Ohio, need not be
followed.

SECTION 3. That the Solicitor for the City of St. Marys, Ohio, be and
he is hereby authorized to prosecute the proceedings necessary to effect
such annexation.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance. The reason
for the emergency lies in the fact that the area, the subject of this
ordinance, is ^{a portion of a subdivided area} to be subdivided into lots for residential dwellings, in the
City of St. Marys, the development of which is necessary to the welfare of
the citizens hereof.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance shall be in force and take effect
immediately upon its passage.
