## ORDINANCE NO. 77;17

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE A PORTION OF SOUTH SPRUCE STREET, BEGINNING AT THE SOUTH LINE OF LOT EIGHT, BLOCK 30, AND THE SOUTH LINE OF LOT FIVE, BLOCK 9, ALL OF THE EAST ADDITION, THENCE SOUTHERLY TO THE TERMINUS OF SAID SPRUCE STREET

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of St. Marys has had public hearings and is considering the vacation of a portion of South Spruce Street, and,

WHEREAS, the City is contemplating that it would be in the best interest economically for the City of St. Marys as a whole to vacate said South Spruce Street.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF ST. MARYS, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Council for the City of St. Marys does hereby vacate all of the right-of-way of South Spruce Street southerly from the South property line of Lot number Eight (8), Block Thirty (30), and Lot number Five (5), Block number Nine (9), of the East Addition to the City of St. Marys, southerly to the terminus of said South Spruce Street.

SECTION 2. Said vacation is vital and necessary since the anticipated expansion of the St. Marys Foundry Company will be in the economic good for the area and the City as a whole, creating economic stability within the community.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect at the earliest possible date provided by law.
