

ORDINANCE NO. 1951

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VACATION
OF GEIGER STREET

WHEREAS, on the 13th day of May, 1963, a petition by persons owning lots in the immediate vicinity of Geiger Street, from Spring Street to Hager Street, was duly presented to council praying that said street between the points named be vacated and notice of the pendency and prayer of said petition has been given as required by law by publication in the St. Marys Evening Leader, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of St. Marys, Ohio, for six consecutive weeks, ending on the 20th day of NOVEMBER, 1963; and

WHEREAS, council upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, and that it is not detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF ST. MARYS, OHIO:

Section 1. That Geiger Street between Spring Street and Hager Street be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. That this ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period provided by law.
