

AN ORDINANCE VACATING AN ALLEY
ADJACENT TO MAPLE STREET AND
PARALLEL TO E. BENTON STREET, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, a petition has been duly presented to Council by
Kenneth and Rosa Kemper, John Marker, Edwin H. & Alvina L. Roth,
praying that a certain alley be vacated, and

WHEREAS, notice of the pendency and prayer of the petition has
been waived as required by law, and

WHEREAS, Council is satisfied that there is good cause for the
vacation as prayed for, and that it will not be detrimental to the
general interest, and ought to be made, now therefore;

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Wapakoneta, County
of Auglaize and State of Ohio, to-wit:

SECTION ONE

THAT a certain east and west alley bounded on the west by the
east right of way line of Maple Street, bounded on the east by the
west line of an 18.0 feet north and south alley, bounded on the north
by the south line of Lots 4, 5 and 6 of the Miller Subdivision of
Out Lot 50, and bounded on the south by the north line of a 70.12
feet by 143.25 feet lot which is part of Lot 7 of the Miller Sub-
division of O.L. 50, is hereby vacated as the interests of the City
of Wapakoneta may ^{if any} appear. *A utility easement is hereby retained over
the parcel being vacated.*

SECTION TWO

THAT the Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure,
it being for the protection, safety and welfare of the citizens of
Wapakoneta, Ohio, so therefore this ordinance shall go into immediate
effect.
