THAT the following described alley is hereby vacated: That certain alley which begins at the northeast corner of Lot Number Two (2) of Bothe's Subdivision of Outlot Forty-two (42) in said City; thence west along the south line of the alley to a point in the north line of Lot Number Eleven (11) of Bothe's Subdivision of Outlot Number Two (2) where the right of way of the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad intersects the north line of bot Number Eleven (11), thence north along the railroad right of way to a point in a the south line of Lot Nine (9) of Bothe's Subdivision of Outlot Number Forty-Two (42); thence east along the south line of said Lot Number Nine (9) to a point which ? is north of the northeast corner of Lot Number Two (2) and eleven (11) feet west of the southeast corner of Lot Number Nine (9); thence South to the point of beginning.
