

Ordinance No 453.

To vacate streets and alleys.

Whereas on the 20th day of November 1895 a petition was presented to Council for the vacation of Vine Race & Plum Streets, from Buchanan Street west ^{to} of Corporation line and all alleys west of Buchanan Street to Corporation line between inlet No 989 ^{and} inlet No. 1002 being in all three alleys and also all alleys lying south of South Street and South Corporation line and between inlet No. 1005 and inlet No. 1012 being four alleys in all. Notice of the pending and prayer of which has been given as required by law; and

Whereas upon hearing the council is satisfied that there is just cause for such vacation in part and that the same would not be detrimental to the general interest and should be made: Therefore, Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Lapakoota that said Race and Plum Streets and three alleys lying between inlet 989 and inlet No. 1002 between Buchanan Street and the Section line between Section 31 and 32 and the four alleys lying between inlet No. 1005 and inlet No. 1012 south of South Street and the south Corporation line Be and the

 this ordinance shall take effect
 and be in force from and after
 the earliest period allowed by law.
