

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE A PORTION OF RICE STREET IN THE CITY OF WAPAKONETA, COUNTY OF AUGLAIZE AND STATE OF OHIO.

WHEREAS, a petition has been duly presented to Council praying that a portion of said street be vacated, that petition having been signed by all of the property owners adjacent to the portion of street and written consent having been given by said property owners in accordance with Section 723.06 of the Ohio Revised Code, and

WHEREAS, Council is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Wapakoneta, State of Ohio, to-wit:

SECTION ONE

THAT so much of Rice Street between the east line of Erie Street and the west line of Wood Street, as lies adjacent to and inbetween lots 1912, 1913 and 1929 in the Westhaven Addition and lot 1 in Westhaven No. 2 Addition, being two parcels of former Rice Street, is hereby vacated.

SECTION TWO

THE City of Wapakoneta, in making this vacation, does expressly reserve a North and South public alley right-of-way at a width of 16.5 feet between the areas designated as vacated.

SECTION THREE

THIS Ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
