

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE AN ALLEY ADJACENT TO  
LOTS 179-181 AND 200-202 IN THE J. AYRES  
NORTH ADDITION TO THE CITY OF WAPAKONETA,  
COUNTY OF AUGLAIZE AND STATE OF OHIO.

WHEREAS, on the 15th day of May, 1984, a petition was duly presented to Council praying that a portion of said alley be vacated, that petition having been signed by the owners of Lots in the City of Wapakoneta in the immediate vicinity of an alley adjacent to Lots 179-181 and 200-202 to be vacated; written consent having been given by said property owners in accordance with Section 723.06 of the Ohio Revised Code, and

WHEREAS, Council is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Wapakoneta State of Ohio, to-wit:

SECTION ONE

THAT the East-West alley between Blackhoof Street on the East and a North-South alley on the West, and being adjacent on the South to lots numbered 179, 180 and 181 and adjacent on the North to lots numbered 200, 201, and 202 is hereby vacated.

SECTION TWO

This Ordinance shall be enforced and take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
