

Ordinance No 387,

Authorizing and permitting the occupancy of a public alley in Wapakoneta, Ohio, by the County of Auglaize for County and Court House purposes.

Sect. II

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Wapakoneta, Ohio, that as the County of Auglaize is the owner of in lots numbered 67, 68, 69, 82, 83 and 84 in said Village of Wapakoneta, Ohio, and as said lots are to be used for Court House and other County purposes, that said County of Auglaize through its Lawful officers and representatives have the exclusive and continued use and occupancy of a public alley extending between in lots numbered sixty seven sixty eight and sixty nine on the north and eighty two, eighty three and eighty four on the south from Millipic Street west to Perry Street between Mechanic Street and Pearl Street, so long as said lots are owned by said Auglaize County and used and occupied for County purposes.

Sect. III

That said Auglaize County is hereby authorized to use said alley or any part thereof for the purpose of constructing and erecting thereon a Court House, or any other structure necessary for County purposes.

Sect. IV

This Ordinance to take effect and be in full force from and after due publication according to Law.
