AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE PART OF A PLATTED 30 FOOT UNIMPROVED UNNAMED STREET AND PART OF HERB STREET IN ANDREW HERBSTREET'S SUB-DIVISION IN THE CITY OF WAPAKONETA, COUNTY OF AUGLAIZE, AND STATE OF OHIO AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on the 4th day of March, 1981, a petition was duly presented to Council praying that a portion of a Platted 30 Foot Unimproved Unnamed Street and a Portion of Herb Street be vacated, that petition having been signed by the Mayor of the City of Wapakoneta for the City of Wapakoneta, owner of the lots in the immediate vicinity of the portions to be vacated, and

WHEREAS Council upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacations prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made;

THEREFORE, Be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Wapakoneta, State of Ohio, to-wit:

Section 1: That so much of a Platted east-west 30 foot unimproved unnamed street as lies adjacent to and in between Outlots numbered eight (8) and nine (9) in Andrew Herbstreet's Sub-division and Outlots numbered ten (10) and eleven (11) in Andrew Herbstreet's Sub-division being a contiguous parcel of a former Platted east-west 30 foot unimproved unnamed street 30 feet and 762.3 feet in dimension is hereby vacated.

Section 2: That so much of Herb Street as lies adjacent to and in between Outlots nine (9) and twenty-six (26) in Andrew Herbstreet's Sub-division being a parcel 30 feet in even width beginning at the southeast corner of said Outlot twenty-six (26) thence running north to the Auglaize River between the east line of said Outlot nine (9) and the west line of said Outlot twenty-six (26)

Section 3: That the Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, it being for the protection, safety and welfare of the citizens of Wapakoneta, Ohio, and for further reason that immediate vacation of said portions of said streets is required in connection with the improvement of the Wastewater Treatment Plant of Wapakoneta, Ohio, so therefore this Ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
