

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE PORTIONS OF QUEEN AND PEACH ALLEYS IN THE EAST SILVER STREET ADDITION TO THE CITY OF WAPAKONETA, COUNTY OF AUGLAIZE, AND STATE OF OHIO.

WHEREAS, on the 18th day of February, 1980 a petition was duly presented to Council praying that portions of Queen and Peach Alleys in the East Silver Street Addition to the City of Wapakoneta be vacated, that petition having been signed by the owners of all of the properties abutting upon the portions of the alleys to be vacated; and notice of the pendency and prayer of the petition has been given as required by law, and

WHEREAS, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WAPAKONETA, AUGLAIZE COUNTY, OHIO:

Section (1) That the hereafter described portions of Queen and Peach Alleys be and the same are hereby vacated. The sections to be vacated are more particularly described as follows:

Situated in the East Silver Street Addition to the City of Wapakoneta, Auglaize County, Ohio, to-wit:

Queen Alley from the west right-of-way line of Highland Street to the east line of King Alley; and Peach Alley from the west right-of-way line of Highland Street to the east line of King Alley. Being the portions of those alleys lying between inlots numbered 1538 and 1539 and between inlots numbered 1542 and 1543.

Section (2) The City of Wapakoneta, in making this vacation, does expressly reserve an easement over, under and through the area designated as Queen Alley for utility purposes. This reservation of an easement shall be automatically vacated upon the acceptance and recording by the Safety-Service Director of an easement for utility purposes over, under and through the property of Walter H. Stinebaugh, Inc.

Section (3) That this ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
