TO VACATE POPPY DRIVE FROM THE WEST
LINE OF STATE ROUTE 198 TO THE EAST
LINE OF GARDENIA DRIVE

Whereas, on the 15th day of January, 1975, a petition by the sole owner of lots in the immediate vicinity of Poppy Drive from the West line of State Route 198 to the East line of Gardenia Drive was duly presented to Council praying that said street, between the points named, be vacated; and notice of the pending and prayer of said petition is not required by law; and

WHEREAS, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WAPAKONETA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Poppy Drive from the West line of State Route 198 to the East line of Gardenia Drive be and the same is hereby vacated.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
