Ordinance No. 23-33 Passed December 19, 197319

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF KREIN AVENUE IN THE CITY OF WAPAKONETA, OHIO

WHEREAS, a petition by persons owning a lot in the immediate vicinity of Krein Avenue lying East of Wilds Street was duly presented to Council proaying that said street be partially vacated between said intersecting streets: and notice of the pendency and prayer of said petition has been given as required by law, and

WHEREAS, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WAPAKONETA, STATE OF OHIO, TO-WIT:

SECTION 1. That the part of Krein Avenue hereinafter described shall be vacated. The portion being vacated is described as follows:

All that part of Krein Avenue lying east of Wilds Street and west of the right of way of the T. & O. C. Railway Company save and except all rights and privileges in an easement along the north side of said Krein Avenue now held by the Penn Central Railroad.

SECTION 2. A copy of this ordinance shall be certified by the Clerk of this Council to the Auglaize County Auditor and Auglaize County R corder.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
