AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF TULIP DRIVE IN THE CITY OF WAPAKONETA, OHIO

WHEREAS, a petition by persons owning a lot in the immediate vicinity of Tulip Drive near its intersection with Aster Drive and Carnation Drive was duly presented to Council praying that said street be partilly vacated between said intersecting streets; and notice of the pendency and prayer of said petition has been given as required by law, and

WHEREAS, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WAPAKONETA, STATE OF OHIO, TO-WIT:

SECTION 1. That that part of Tulip Drive hereinafter described shall be vacated. The Portion being vacated is described as follows:

So much of Tulip Drive as lies South of the South line of Aster Drive to a point three hundred (300) feet South of the Said South line of aster Drive.

SECTION 2. A copy of this ordinance shall be certified by the Clerk of this Council to the Auglaize County Auditor and Auglaize County Recorder.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall be and remian in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
