

Ordinance No 271

An Ordinance to Vacate a Certain Alley between
lots No 688 689 690 and 691 692 and 693 in Wapakoneta
Ohio

Be it ordained by the Council of the incorporated
Village of Wapakoneta, Ohio, that whereas John
Hannenburg and others on the 6th day of April 1886,
presented a petition to said Council praying
for the vacation of a part of a certain alley to wit:
All that part of an alley between lots No 688
689 690 and 691 692 and 693 in said Village, and
whereas said Council is satisfied that due ^{and} legal
notice of the filing and object of said petition
has been given as requested by law, and said
Council being further satisfied that there is good
cause for the vacation of said alley, and that
the said vacation will not be detrimental to
the public but that the same should be
made, therefore be it ordained that said part
of said alley be and the same is hereby vacated,
and that said notice be spread upon the minutes of
this meeting.

This Ordinance to take effect and be in force after
legal publication thereof.
