AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE THE ALLEY ADJACENT TO THE ENTIRE
NORTH SIDE OF LOT NUMBER TEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN (1077)
IN THE CITY OF WAPAKONETA, OHIO.

WHEREAS a petition by persons owning a lot in the immediate vicinity of the alley adjacent to the entire north side of lot number ten hundred seventy-seven (1077) in the City of Wapakoneta, Ohio was duly presented to Council praying that said alley be vacated along the part of its length that adjoins said lot number ten hundred seventy seven (1077); and notice of the pendency and prayer of said petition has been given as required by law, and

WHEREAS, Council upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WAPAKONETA, STATE OF OHIO, to-wit:

SECTION 1. That the alley adjacent to the entire north side of lot number Ten Hundred Seventy-Seven (1077) in the City of Wapakoneta, Ohio, be vacated along that part of its length that adjoins said lot number Ten Hundred Seventy-Seven (1077).

SECTION 2. A copy of this Ordinance shall be certified to the County Recorder by the Clerk.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
