

Ordinance No. 2353

AN ORDINANCE VACATING AN ALLEY BETWEEN JACKSON AND HARRISON
STREETS

WHEREAS there has been presented to Council a petition from Gladys M. Boltz and James Boltz, they being all of the abutting landowners to a certain alley located between Jackson and Harrison Streets, requesting the vacating of said alley; and,

WHEREAS Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation; that it will not be detrimental to the general interest; and ought to be made; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Wapakoneta, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the alley running in a northeast and southwest direction and lying between Lot 714 and Lots 721, 722 and 723 from Jackson Street to the southern end of said alley, as shown by the Plat of Roth's addition to the City of Wapakoneta, Ohio, be and the same is hereby vacated.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
