## AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF WILDS STREET

Whereas, there has been presented to Council a petition from the Fisher Cheese Co., a landowner in the immediate vicinity of Wilds Street, requesting a vacating of a portion of said Wilds Street; and,

Whereas, all of the remaining property owners have consented to the vacation as prayed for, as required by law; and,

Whereas, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation; that it will not be detrimental to the general interest; and ought to be made; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Wapakoneta, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the East Fifteen feet of wilds street, from the North lot line of Lot number 1373 to the South lot line of Lot Number 1379, be and the same is hereby vacated.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

SECTION 3. This vacation is conditioned on the completion of the construction proposed in the plans and specifications attached to the said petition within two years from the effective date of this ordinance.
