

# RECORD OF ORDINANCES

2808-A

Ordinance No. 2301

Passed January 6, 1965

TO VACATE A PORTION OF AND A CONTINUATION OF LIMA STREET  
EAST OF WOOD STREET AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

Whereas, on the 6th day of January, 1965, a written consent signed by all of the persons owning land abutting that portion of the street sought to be vacated, and said consent including all persons owning lots or land in the immediate vicinity of a continuation of Lima Street, east of Wood Street, and, has been filed with the Council of the City of Wapakoneta, and

Whereas, Council upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation and prayed for and consented to, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WAPAKONETA, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That a continuation of Lima Street, East of Wood Street, and described as follows:

"A strip of land fifty (50) feet wide running east and west along the line between lots 4 and 5 in Meeker's Subdivision in said City of Wapakoneta, Ohio, the south line of said strip being 465.9 feet north and parallel to the north line of Pike Street in said city of Wapakoneta, be and the same is hereby vacated. The Services Director of Wapakoneta, as and for the City of Wapakoneta, is also hereby authorized to convey the said strip of land by quit-claim deed to the new owner.

SECTION 2. In order to protect the public health, welfare and safety of the City of Wapakoneta, Ohio, this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall go into immediate effect.
