

Ordinance No. 2001

Passed August 1 1956

TO VACATE A CERTAIN ALLEY LYING  
BETWEEN LOTS 1 AND 2 AND 8 OF DREXLER'S  
ADDITION FROM JACKSON STREET WEST TO AN  
ALLEY RUNNING NORTH AND SOUTH WEST OF  
LOTS 1 AND 8 IN SAID ADDITION.

WHEREAS, on the 5th day of July, 1956, a petition by persons owning lots in the immediate vicinity of certain alley lying between lots 1 and 2 and 8 of Drexler's Addition from Jackson Street west to an alley running north and southwest of lots 1 and 8 in the said Addition, was duly presented to Council praying that said alley, between the points named, be vacated; and notice of the pendency and prayer of said petition not being required all property owners in the immediate vicinity have consented to the immediate vacation; and

WHEREAS, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Wapakoneta, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That a certain alley lying between lots 1 and 2 and 8 of Drexler's Addition from Jackson Street west to an alley running north and southwest of lots 1 and 8 in said Drexler's Addition be and the same is hereby vacated.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
