

Ordinance 209

To vacate part of a certain alley in Wapakoneta Ohio

Sec 1

Be it ordained by the council of the Incorporated village of Wapakoneta Ohio That whereas S. H. Sumner Minister President of the Wapakoneta Spoke and wheel company and others on the 15th day of January AD 1883 presented a petition to said Council praying for the vacation of a part of a certain alley as follows to wit all of that part of said alley that lies between lots No 494 and 495 and running from Walcutt Street west to the Dayton and Michigan Railway in said village and whereas said Council is satisfied that due and legal notice of the filing of said petition has been given as required by Law and said Council being further satisfied that there is good cause for the vacation of said alley that the said vacation will not be detrimental to the public in fact and that the same should be made therefore be it ordained that said part of said alley be and the same is hereby vacated and that said petition spread

Sec 2

This ordinance take effect and be in force after notice be spread upon the minutes of this meeting legal publication thereof and passed this 5 day of March AD 1883
