Ordinance No. 1942

Passed Aug. 3

1955

TO VACATE AN ALLEY FROM THE SOUTHWEST
CORNER OF LOT NUMBER 244 AND FROM THE
SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTH TWO-THIRDS
OF LOT NUMBER 270 TO THE SOUTH LINE OF
WEST BENTON STREET IN THE CITY OF WAPA-
KONETA, OHIO.

WHEREAS, on the 20th day of July, 1955, a petition by persons owning lots in the immediate vicinity of an alley from the southwest corner of lot number 244 and from the southeast corner of the north two-thirds of lot number 270 to the south line of West Benton Street was duly presented to Council praying that said alley, between the points named, be vacated: and

WHEREAS, notice of the intention of the legislative authority to vacate said alley between the points named is required; and

WHEREAS, Council is satisfied there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made, provided that the City of Wapakoneta reserves the right of ingress and egress over and through said vacated alley for the purpose of maintaining and erecting utility poles and power lines,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WAPAKONETA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the alley from the southwest corner of lot number 244 and from the southeast corner of the north two-thirds of lot number 270 to the south line of West Benton Street in the City of Wapakoneta, Ohio, be and the same is hereby vacated reserving unto the City of Wapakoneta, Ohio, the right of ingress and egress over and through said vacated alley for the purpose of maintaining and erecting utility poles and power lines.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
