Ordinance No. 1908

Passed Dec. 1, 1954

TO VACATE JOHN STREET FROM A POINT ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY FEET WEST OF THE WEST LINE OF BLACKHOOF STREET TO THE WEST LINE OF BLACKHOOF STREET AND ALSO FROM A POINT ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY FEET EAST OF THE EAST LINE OF BLACKHOOF STREET TO THE EAST LINE OF BLACKHOOF STREET.

WHEREAS, on the 1st day of September, 1954, a petition by persons owning lots in the immediate vicinity of John Street between a point one hundred fifty feet west of the west line of Blackhoof Street and a point one hundred fifty feet east of the east line of Blackhoof Street was duly presented to Council praying that said John Street, between the points named, be vacated, and

WHEREAS, notice of the filing of said petition and of the date that said petition would be considered by the Council was duly published as provided by law, and

WHEREAS, no objections were made to the vacation of said street between the points named, and

WHEREAS, the Council is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will be be detrimental to the general interest and that the vacation ought to be made.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Wapakoneta, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That John Street from a point one hundred and fifty feet west of the west line of Blackhoof Street to the west line of Blackhoof Street and also from a point one hundred and fifty feet east of the east line of Blackhoof Street to the east line of Blackhoof Street be and the same is hereby vacated.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance be and shall remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
