

Ordinance No. 1756

Passed August 15, 1951

TO VACATE AN ALLEY ON SOUTH END OF INLOT # 425

Whereas, on the 4th day of April, 1951, a petition by persons owning lots in the immediate vicinity of the alley running east and west along the south end of Inlot #425 in the City of Wapakoneta, Auglaize County, Ohio, was duly presented to council praying that said alley, described as all that part of the alley east of the east line of Broadway and west of the east line of lots #148 and #425 and being a strip 16½ feet wide, be vacated; and notice of the pendency and prayer of said petition has been given as required by law, by publication in the Wapakoneta Daily News, a newspaper of general circulation in the corporation, for six consecutive weeks ending on the 16th day of May, 1951: and

Whereas, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made, now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL of the City of Wapakoneta, Ohio.

Section 1. That all that part of the alley east of the east line of Broadway Street and west of the east line of lots 148 and 425 and being 16½ feet wide in said city be and the same hereby is vacated, as shown by plat hereto attached.

Section 2. That this ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
