

Ordinance No. 1740

Passed February 7, 1950

TO VACATE 150 FT. OFF THE WEST END OF MARY STREET

WHEREAS, on the 20th day of September, 1950, a petition by persons owning lots in the immediate vicinity of Mary Street, was duly presented to council praying that a portion of said street be vacated to-wit:

One hundred fifty (150) feet off the west end of said street, and more particularly described as follows:

That part of Mary Street lying west of the west line of Gibbs Avenue and running thence a distance of 150 feet west between Inlots numbered 1767 and 1768 in Gibbs First Addition to the City of Wapakoneta;

and notice of the pendency and prayer of said petition has been given as required by law, by publication in the Wapakoneta Daily News, a newspaper of general circulation in the corporation, for six consecutive weeks ending December 5, 1950.

WHEREAS, council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made, Now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the council of the City of Wapakoneta, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That 150 feet off the west end of Mary Street, more particularly described as follows:

That part of Mary Street lying West line of Gibbs Avenue and running thence a distance of 150 feet west between Inlots numbered 1767 and 1768 in Gibbs First Addition to the City of Wapakoneta; be and the same is hereby vacated.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance be and remain in force from after the earliest period allowed by law.
