

Ordinance No 101.

Vacating certain alleys therein named
petitioned for by H. C. Bettlage & others.

Section I. Be it ordained by the
Council of the incorporated Village of
Wapakoneta, Ohio, that the following described
alleys in said Village to wit: The alleys
running north and south from Auglaize Street
between inlots No. 795 and out lot No. 134, and
between inlots No. 790 and 791 and between
inlot No. 786 and out lot No. 137. Also the
alley running east and West in the rear of
inlots No. 786 to 795 both inclusive, be and
the same is hereby vacated, said Council
being satisfied that there is good cause for
such vacation, and that the same will not
be detrimental to the public interests.

Section II This ordinance passed
August 5th 1878, and to take effect on and
after its first publication according to law.
