ORDINANCE NO. 1480

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE AND NARROW OAK STREET TO THE EXTENT OF THREE (3) FEET OF UNIFORM WIDTH ALONG EACH SIDE OF SAID STREET FROM BENTON STREET TO PEARL STREET IN THE CITY OF WAPAKONETA, OHIO

WHEREAS, on the 16th day of July, 1941, a petition by persons owning Lots in the immediate vicinity of Oak Street from Benton Street to Pearl Street in said City was duly presented to Council praying that said Street between the points named be vacated and narrowed to the extent of three (3) feet of uniform width along each side of said Oak Street, and,

WHEREAS, in said petition all the owners of Lots abutting the part of said Street proposed to be vacated have filed with Council written consent to such vacation, and,

WHEREAS, Council upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Wapakoneta, State of Ohio:-

SECTION 1. That Oak Street in the City of Wapakoneta, from Benton Street to Pearl Street be and the same is hereby wacated and narrowed to the extent of three (3) feet of uniform width along each side of said Oak Street.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
